

I am a member of the advisory board of the ERA-PRO EU FP6 contract, which is involved in creating the European radiobiology archive. We are in the process of applying for new funding to extend the archive work to look at the possibility of using modern molecular methods on the materials from old radiobiology experiments. We would prefer to locate the meeting in Warsaw if the infrastructure costs. We are also working in partnership with the US DOE and the Japanese NIRS to make better use of archival sources. I envisage a small workshop (1 day maximum) with about 20-50 attendees. We can fund the workshop ourselves, but would like to associate with the ICRR to achieve maximum impact. Costs are reasonable, and this would probably bring a few more guests to the ICRR as this is a new topic with some interesting aspects (2D protein gels from 40 year old paraffin blocks!!).
